I have been teaching PE for over two decades, both in mainstream and for the last eighteen years, in SEN. During my teaching career, I have been both a Head of Department in a large Grant Maintained Comprehensive school in Surrey and Director of Sport in my current place of employment. I received a promotion to Assistant Headteacher at the SEN school within the Basingstoke community, which I have thoroughly enjoyed.

In this role I am the Pastoral lead, typically developing; consistent approaches to behaviour for learning, pupil attendance, enrichment opportunities and the mental health and wellbeing of staff and pupils.

As Assistant Headteacher of a local SEN school that offers a Post 16 pathway I have a good understanding of our local SEND provision post 16/19. I believe that learners should have the essential information to make informed choices about their futures.

In my role within the education system, I support learners and their parents/ carers better understand where and what the local colleges offer in order for them to choose pathways wisely. I also lead a team that facilitates post 16 information evenings to parents/ carers.

As a Pastoral lead, my team also supports the transition of our pupils into colleges and at Post 16, the supported internships. We work with other local colleges to ensure suitable exit routes and courses for our learners.

Whilst not directly involved with our own Post 16 provision, as a member of Senior Leadership Team, we regularly discuss study programmes and placements, as the Post 16 provision offers supported internships. We discuss the appropriateness of qualifications and the preparing for the Adulthood agenda. We are guided by a curriculum that is designed as much as possible, to prepare learners for employment.
